

Artificial Green Walls

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With regards to sustainability and the Vistafolia products' green credentials, here are some key points:

- 1. The packaging is all responsibly sourced and fully recyclable
- 2. The plants are similarly recyclable through either specialist facilities, or through our own in-house recycling processes. In any case, no plants ever need to end up in landfill.
- 3. There is also no water or chemical usage throughout the product life time, and our green walls contain less plastic per m2 than a living green wall does.

In addition, through our internal research and partnership with <u>Brothers Make</u>, our artificial green wall panels can now be recycled and re-purposed for a different means, making Vistafolia the only artificial plant wall supplier with the knowledge and ability to do this.

Combined with the research towards sustainable artificial foliage, Vistafolia is aiming to develop a sustainable product at all stages of its life cycle, meaning our faux living wall is the only choice for those who are looking for a more environmentally friendly product.

However, one of the biggest areas we are working towards in conjunction with the University of Surrey is our KTP project. We are working towards developing a bio-polymer that we can manufacture the products from and reduce our carbon footprint as a business. A move to a fully renewable source for manufacturing would be a market first and shows our commitment to a greener future for our industry.
